Accommodation Status

Jade	Comments
Independent/Family Home	Living in a whanau home or own home
Caregiver/Foster (not private)	In formal foster care or paid caregiver home
Shared / Stable	Flattng or other shared accommodation that is secure and stable
Shared / Unstable or Temporary	Boarding, hostel, motor camp, shelter, another family's home. Tenuous or else short term accommodation
Supported / NDHB or NGO	Inpatient, NGO residential
Supported / Institutional	Prison
Supported / Other	Rest home
Uninhabitable housing	Dilapidated beyond social norms
Homeless	Makeshift, transient

Education and Training

If they are completing more than one of these, just record the highest level of education they are attending

Preschool	Regularly (at least once per week) attending a preschool. 4 years and under.
School	If 5 - 16 and attending registered education provider
School / Poor attendance	If 5 to 16 and averaging 4 or less days/week in the prior month (excluding holidays).
School / Not attending	If 5 to 16 and less than 50% attendance in prior month (excluding holidays).
School / Alt Ed	If 5 to 16 and after being excluded from school, have been enrolled in Alternative Education
Home School	5 - 16 and under and formally in home schooling
Education / Training	17+ and attending a registered NZQA education or training. School, Tech, Uni, ITO, Wananga, Private or Govt.
Not in Education / Training	17+ and NOT attending a registered NZQA education or training. School, Tech, Uni, ITO, Wananga, Private or Govt etc
Community Education (if not in other edu)	17+ and NOT attending a registered NZQA education or training but is attending a community education programme
Daily Activity/Living Skills Programme (if not in other edu)	17+ and NOT attending/engaged in registered NZQA education or training but is attending an NDHB or NGO skills or educational programme
